Australian Charts

It is recommended to use the 800 series as a minimum along the Australian East coast, and detailed charts as required by the itinerary. The 4000 series planning charts are useful for a long range overview and ocean passages




Cruising the Coral Coast

Currents, tides and weather are all discussed in detail. Consideration is given to alternative anchorages, such as when the predominant SE trades change to a northerly aspect.





In this and its sister books, Leslie Richards has provided basic, but detailed information on anchorages along the Northern Australian coast. Most entries include an anchorage diagram, as well as Aus chart, light and tide references. A paragraph on each anchorage provides guidance on entry and where to drop anchor. Leslie Richards has spent over 20 years sailing across Northern Australia.





Ken Hellewell cruised through the Torres Strait and put together this cruising guide of the area while travelling single handed. It includes Charts, Waypoints, Photos, Customs and Quarantine Procedures; with a focus on the Raine Island Route through the Great Barrier Reef.

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South East Asia & the Indian Ocean

Boat Books has three cruising guides suitable for the trip northwards from Darwin. The Imray publication Southeast Asia Cruising Guide Vol 2 is the first pick for those making the trip along the Archipelago, with 101 Anchorages a good supplement. The Southeast Asia Pilot is best for those going to Thailand, with the new 4th edition providing additional coverage of parts of Indonesia. (The Imray South East Asia Cruising Guide Vol 1 covering the Philippines, and coasts of the South China Sea is currently out of print and is being updated for reprint.)




Southeast Asia Cruising Guide Vol 2 (Imray) Davies & Morgan

Area covered PNG, East Timor, Indonesia, Malaysia, West Thailand

This is the book of choice for cruisers heading from Darwin through Indonesia to Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand. It is also excellent for the more northerly trip via PNG, Palau, and then through Indonesia. Stephen Davies and Elaine Morgan's detailed text provides cruise planning information, an extensive discussion on climate, technical data concerning radio and weather forecasting services and general background commentary on each country. Each region is then treated in detail and pilotage information is given for key harbours. This pilot is a unique source of information for cruise planning and also will be an essential reference for yachtsmen on passage.

Recently reprinted, 101 Anchorages covers cruising anchorages throughout Indonesia, mostly along the Sunda Islands Archipelago (Timor to Java), but also Maluku, Sulawesi, Kalimantan & Sumatra. Each anchorage includes a rating, approach suggestions, hazards, weather suitability, pictures, maps, water clarity, local facilities & attractions, all presented in an easy to read sailing format. It covers more cruising anchorages than the Imray Guide, although in less detail. Certainly worth getting if cruising through Indonesia.


Area covered Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Andaman Is

New 4th edition of the Southeast Asia Pilot, is particularly strong on both coasts of Thailand and Malaysia. It also has increased coverage of Indonesia (though not as strong as the Imray or 101 Anchorages) including Timor, Flores, Bali, Java, Ambon, Sulawesi, Kalimantan Borneo, Sabah and Raja Ampat. India's Andaman Islands are also well covered. Other areas with lighter coverage include: Singapore, Cambodia, Vietnam, Hong Kong & the Philippines. Anchorages and marinas are reviewed with: detailed charts including GPS positions; marinas & anchorage information, regattas & boatshows.





Admiralty Sailing Directions

Admiralty Sailing Directions are written for shipping, hence place considerable emphasis on ports and harbour for ships and deepwater anchorages. They can provide useful information for cruisers, especially if there is no equivalent cruising guide for the area. They have handy aerial and sea level photographs to help identify major landmarks.

All Admiralty Pilots are \$147.75 each.
